Our 4th Grade students will be singing excerpts from their musical, "Let's Sing, America!" We want to honor your service and sacrifice for our nation's freedoms. Our speaker is Barry Reeder. Major (retired) Barry R. Reeder is originally from Garrison, Kentucky and graduated from Lewis County High School in 1989. Upon graduation, Barry joined the U.S. Air Force and worked in the Aerospace Physiology and Human Performance Research fields for more than twenty years. During his five assignments at differing locations, he was responsible for training 15,000 U.S. and NATO aircrew in the areas of human performance in flight. Barry was also involved with developing warfighter

protection technologies at the Air Force Research Laboratory at Wright Patterson Air Force Base. He is a graduate of Embry Riddle Aeronautical University and earned an MBA from DeVry University. Barry currently resides in Waynesville with his wife Adeline and three daughters, Sarah, Hannah, and Olivia.



Waynesville Elementary is proud to present **Dr. John Becker** and staff from the Columbus Zoo on Thursday, December 1, 2011. In Dr. Becker's newest book, Frenemies for Life, he writes about the unlikely friendships forged between the endangered cheetah and Anatolian shepherd dogs. The Cheetah Conservation Fund discovered that this special breed of dogs has the right stuff to protect herds by chasing off the hungry cheetahs. With these dogs around, farmers no longer need to kill these cats. Due to this conservation project the cheetah population has begun to rise. A portion of the book sales and school assembly go to help purchase an Anatolian shepherd dog to be placed on a farm in Africa. During his assembly, Dr. Becker will tell the story behind the book, share video from the field research he conducted in writing the book, and the role the book plays in cheetah conservation. Then, members from the Columbus zoo will bring out a young cheetah and an Anatolian shepherd puppy for students to see.

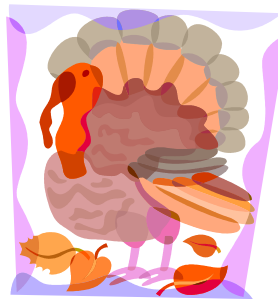
