## WAYNESVILLE HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETICS Fall Season Re-Cap

Waynesville athletes worked hard throughout the summer to prepare for this season and their efforts paid off. Our high school is leading the SWBL for the All-Sports trophy because so many fall teams did so well. The teams won two SWBL titles in Boys Golf and in Girls Tennis. We had four second place finishes in Boys and Girls Soccer, Girls Cross Country and Football, and two fourth place finishes in Volleyball and Boys Cross Country. Two high school athletes had great individual performances this fall. Freshman tennis player Alyssa Ritchie qualified for the State Tennis Tournament at OSU; she won her first match to place in the top eight in Ohio. Another great individual highlight was earned by junior cross country athlete Bobbi Wilson, who made it to the Regionals after finishing first in the Buckeye division at the league meet. In addition, both Alyssa and Bobbi are honors students who made straight A's this fall. Our football team advanced to the state playoffs for the first time since 1999. Many WHS student athletes are also great leaders in their academic studies, as 102 of 189 fall athletes were on the honor roll and 89 student athletes had GPA's above 3.50.

## SPARTAN MARCHING BAND Season Re-Cap

The Spartan Marching Band battled the heat while learning their 2007 show, "SUPERHEROES!" The band was more than ready to perform the first half of the show at the first football game against East Clinton. The band performed the entire show for the very first time at the Homecoming football game on September 28. In addition, the band welcomed for the first time alumni band members to perform for pre-game and halftime at Homecoming. It was a great event for everyone!

The first band competition was held in Lebanon on October 6. The band came home with a third place trophy for Class AAA and placed eighth overall out of fourteen bands. The drum line posted their best scores ever, coming in second in Class AAA and third place overall. The following weekend the band performed at the Sauerkraut Festival. On October 20 the band traveled to Colerain High School to compete against 27 bands. It was a solid performance, with many improvements; however the judges were pretty tough so the band placed eighth in our class and twenty-fourth overall. The final October competition was on the 27th at Mason. The band posted their best scores of the season. The Spartans earned another third place trophy for Class AAA and finished seventeenth overall.

This past weekend the Spartan Marching Band performed at the Bands of America Grand Nationals Championships, held at the RCA Dome in Indianapolis. This is an event the band looks forward to all year as they have the opportunity to see and compete against 84 other bands from all over the country.
