Canned Goods Drive

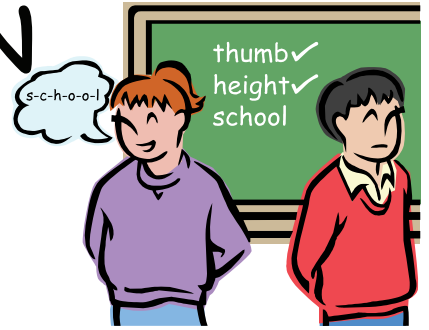
