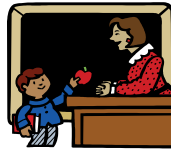
You are invited to register your child at the Waynesville Elementary lobby, 659 Dayton Road, on the following dates:

Kindergarten Screening

will be scheduled on Thursday, May 6th and Friday, May 7th, 2010,

at First Baptist Church. During that time your child will be screened by one of our kindergarten teachers and school nurse. Screening will determine placement for the Young Fives, Extended Day or regular AM/PM class. You will be notified of your child's screening results by June 11th.

Please bring the following papers that are required for enrolling your child:

- **Child's official birth certificate** (from the Bureau of Vital Statistics) - we cannot accept the child's hospital record
- **Social security card**
- **Custody papers** stating who is the custodial parent for school enrollment
- **Copy of parent/guardian driver's license**
- **Proof of residency:** for proof of residency we will accept one of the following: rental/lease agreement, purchase contract, copy of deed, settlement statement, land contract. (see packet's enclosed sheet on residency/enrollment requirements)
- **Enrollment, transportation and health forms**

Please note: You must have submitted **all** of the above paperwork to be eligible for a screening May 6-7.
