Steps taken to prevent and reduce incidents of bullying, harassment, and intimidation:

- Provide resources to parent/students via website, Good News Friday, and Solutions enrollment packets for in-school therapy
- Monitor students' behavior in "hot spots" during peak times
- Address concerns to students through grade level meetings
- Continue Spartan Star Card program to reward positive behavior
- Administrator/Guidance Counselor to assist students in conflict resolution
- Hold REDO Assembly in Fall 2014 to Seventh and Eighth grade students
- Use wall space in the middle school to promote positive behaviors
- Meet with parents and students as needed
