
Installation:

It is your responsibility to ensure this is permitted in your neighborhood (i.e. HOA) and to identify any utility supply lines, sprinkler systems, pet containment systems which must be avoided during installation.

Installation location should be 12-18" from the curb/street, near the center of your lawn.

We will install a flagpole sleeve made from a one foot section of PVC pipe in your yard, 18 inches from the curb/street. This pipe will be installed low enough not to interfere with regular lawn mowing.

We will paint a BSA Fleur de Lis symbol on the curb/street to mark the location of the sleeve.
