- Used In-house Mental Health Consultant to work with students
- Contacted Transportation to move student's seat on bus and make driver aware of situation
- Worked with Classroom Teacher and Guidance Counselor to adjust schedule to separate students
- Conferenced in person, over the phone, and through emails with parents
- Recommendations made for students to talk to counselor or seek outside counseling
